New handguns in the home increase suicide risk (Studdert et al NEJM 2020)

• Male handgun owners 3.4x as likely to kill themselves if they own a handgun because they have a 7.8x increased risk of firearm suicide


• Female handgun owners 7.1x as likely to kill themselves if they own a handgun because they have a 35x increased risk of firearm suicide

• "Handgun owners did not have higher rates of suicide by other methods or higher all cause mortality."

• 48% of the suicides were within one year of purchase

Too early to be certain about new trends in firearm injuries and deaths

• Violent crime: mixed by region, mostly gun crime has not gone down

• Suicide: too early to know; no clear signal. Lots of hyped fake news

• Intimate partner violence: Inconsistent, increased in some areas; calls initiated by witnesses > targets

• Mass shootings: Fewer school shootings; maybe fewer mass killings but May was historic record setting mass shootings

• Accidental: Some early unconfirmed reports from Everytown of significant increases
